

Airport:

Dublin Airport which is 176km from the hotel.

GETTING HERE

By car:

Dooley's Hotel Waterford does not have it's own private car park. The Merchants Quay Car Park is located directly opposite the hotel. There are multiple accessible parking spaces located in this car park.

By Train:

We want our hotel to be your home away from home and we have a range of accessibility features to support you during your stay which are summarised below.

INFORMATION

Large-print information: We have the following information in large print on-site: Registration Cards, Terms & Conditions, Menus.

Tactile signage: Tactile signage is available. This includes Braille.

SERVICES

Disability awareness or equality training: Disability awareness or equality training is provided for staff.

Assistance available 24 hours: There is 24-hour guest assistance available.

Emergency evacuation plan for guests with disabilities or access requirements: Personal or General Emergency Evacuation Plans are in place for guests with disabilities.



Free familiarisation visits: Free familiarisation visits are available. Guests are welcome to arrange a visit ahead of booking or visiting to familiarise themselves or others with the venue at no additional cost.

FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT


Emergency alarm with flashing lights: There is an emergency alarm with strobe or flashing lights, to alert deaf guests to a fire or other emergency scenario. Available in all public areas of the hotel and in bedrooms.

Facilities for assistance dogs: Facilities are available for assistance dogs e.g. water bowls, toilet area, etc.

Enclosed outdoor area: There is an enclosed outdoor area for customer use.

Sensory equipment: We have a sensory box available at the front desk.

Wheelchair or scooter charging point: There is at least one wheelchair or scooter charging point.



Wheelchair accessible toilet in public areas: There is a wheelchair accessible toilet in the lobby of the hotel. This toilet has:

- Step-free access
- A large manoeuvring space
- A transfer space on one side of the toilet with a drop-down grab rail
- Horizontal grab rail positioned on the wall adjacent to the toilet
- An emergency assistance alarm within reach from the floor

PARKING

Accessible parking: The Merchant's Quay Car Park located directly opposite the hotel has multiple accessible parking spaces available. As we do not have our own car park, we recommend guests to use this car park for convenience. This car park is private and additional costs may apply.

Step-free route with firm surface from car park to entrance: There is a step-free route with a firm surface from the parking to the main entrance of the hotel. The hotel is less than 100m from the car park.

BUILDING ENTRANCE

Step-Free Entrance: The main entrance to the hotel is step-free with two doors opening to a width of 160cm.



ACCESS TO PUBLIC AREAS

Step-free access to all public areas: Step free access to the hotel lobby, Dry Dock Bar, New Ship Restaurant, Rita Nolan Suite, and public bathrooms.

Lift: There is one lift available providing access to all 4 floors of the hotel. Our accessible bedrooms have full step-free access although some rooms on the higher floors require guests to take some steps to access their room. **Stairs:** The stairs include handrails.


RESTAURANT AND BAR

Wheelchair-accessible food and beverage outlet: Both have step-free access, wide aisles to allow manoeuvrability, and accessible seating areas with tables at appropriate heights.

Quieter table: A table located in a quieter area is available, where noise is minimised.

Table service: Table service is standard for food service, and is available upon request for drinks service.

Dietary Requirements: We cater for all dietary requirements.



BEDROOMS & BATHROOMS

Bedroom with en-suite bathroom: All bedrooms have an en-suite bathroom.

Shower Unit: Some bedrooms have a walk-in/wheelchair accessible shower, while others have a shower over a bath. Walk-in shower available on request.

Fridge: Our bedrooms do not come equipped with fridges, although medication can be stored safely in a fridge upon request.

Furniture rearranged in bedroom on request: To create additional space, furniture can be rearranged on request.

Wheelchair Accessible Bedrooms & Bathrooms: We have wheelchair accessible bedrooms/bathrooms with step-free access, door width of 80cm, internal circulation space of 1.5mX1.5m, an emergency assistance alarm, and a bed height of 50cm. Bathrooms are equipped with roll-in showers, emergency assistance alarms, shower seat, transfer space on one side of toilet, grab rails. Floor surfaces are firm, level, and slip-resistant.

Twin or double bed options in wheelchair-accessible rooms: Both double and twin bed configurations are available across wheelchair-accessible bedrooms. Not all configurations may be available in every room.
